Call to order and minutes: The meeting was called to order at 2:01 P.M. by Chairperson Cindy Bosch. The motion to approve minutes from the February, 2017 meeting was made by Ginger May with a second by Bert Paul. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Cindy Bosch reviewed the Committee's norm of holding no meetings during June, July, and August. There were no objections.

- Bert Paul suggested that sand traps be considered for revision this summer to ensure that entry does not require steps that are too deep. Cindy Bosch tabled this for Bill Todd's return.
- Jack Hill reported that some areas of PV rough are thin, but will grow back given the change of weather.
- Ginger Mays requested additional rakes for greenside bunkers on CW's 17th hole, since the shortage tends to slow the pace of play. Cindy Bosch tabled this for Bill Todd's return.
