Chairman Richard Hair called the meeting to order at 3 p.m. An amendment to the minutes of the April meeting was read. A motion to approve the minutes including the amendment was made by Cindy Bosch, seconded by Jim Gillispie. Motion approved

Staff Reports:

<u>Bill Todd</u> reported five days of low humidity and wind has made it hard to keep water on the courses. Special areas on the back nine at Cottonwood will be getting attention as needed. Aerification of greens will begin the first week of June on Cottonwood and will begin June 9th on Palo Verde.

Summer projects will include leveling of selected tee boxes during monsoon. Some trees will need to be removed on Palo Verde by the right side of number 18 and the left side of number 9 to encourage grass to grow. The fence lines on Palo Verde have limited grass because water runs off the slopes. Some areas in front of fences will be selected for seeding and sod will be added on selected patches.

Future projects will include bunker renovation, cart path replacements and development of a conceptual plan for the Palo Verde practice area.

Rita Benfer had questions for Bill from the CW 18 hole ladies April committee meeting.

Would it be possible to have 7 a.m. shotguns on Thursday? Bill will consider after June.

There is a need for signage going into both sides of the tunnel under Alma School. Bill agreed.

Can the rakes go back into the bunkers? There was discussion by the committee. Rita made a motion, seconded by Dean Hermanson to put rakes into the bunkers. Motion failed.

Are big tires on some of the newer golf carts "regulation?' If there is a question the pro's ask Bill who has several maintenance vehicles with large tires which don't harm the golf courses.

Bill suggested a sub-committee be formed to make suggestions and meet with Mike Gogle who will come up with a conceptual plan for the practice facility at Palo Verde. The sub-committee is: Dick Howell, Cindy Bosch, Jack Hill, Liz Hall, Richard Hair and Greg Tokash. The sub-committee will meet with Mike and Bill Wednesday, May 7th at 7 a.m. Don Hicks reviewed the process. A conceptual plan will be designed, then brought to the Golf Committee for review and "tweaking". The committee will approve the plan and then forward to the Facility and Grounds Committee for their approval prior to submission to the Board of Directors.

Greg and Desmond would like to make that a standard event for the Assistants. Joe Ficek asked about revenue since golf rounds are down. Golf Comment Cards – April – Six

Card Received March 31, 2014. Golfer would like clarification of rules on Cottonwood #16 when golf ball goes into either lake. The golf pros recommended using the designated drop area on the south edge of the green. The solution was posted on the web-site "in-the-know".

Four cards received April 10, 2014. The CW lady 9er's requested a revised shot-gun when the CW 18 hole ladies have a special event that pushes the afternoon shot-gun back sometimes by ½ hour to 45 minutes depending on the event. Desmond referred the Executive Committee of the 9er's to meet with the 18 hole ladies to coordinate calendars so that the 9 hole ladies know which days will have a delayed shot-gun.
